Pantry Rules and Guidelines 2025

Hours of Operation:

- We are open Monday and Wednesday 9:30 AM — 12:30 PM and Thursday evening 5:30 - 7:00 PM.
- Client intake ends at 12:00 SHARP. On Thursday evening, it ends at 6:30 PM SHARP. • The pantry is closed for severe weather when Romeo Community Schools are closed.

Visiting the Pantry:

- Each household will be offered 12 months of visits.
- In accordance with the Agape Board policy, food will not be delivered by pantry volunteers. Each client is responsible for picking up their own food during pantry hours. If this is not possible, a Proxy Statement must be filled out at the time of registration with the pantry. The Proxy Statement allows the client to give permission to someone else to pick up food on his/her behalf.
- Food orders are delivered curbside. You will call the pantry when you arrive at 586-336-6737. Our volunteers will prepare your food in the order it was received and wheel it outside for you to load your vehicle.
- Eligibility to be a pantry client is on a self-declared basis. You will be asked to sign a form at each visit to verify your household income falls within the range of eligibility.

Pantry Abuse:

- Households found visiting more than ONE pantry per month will not be able to visit Agape Pantry in the future. No exceptions.
- You can only be signed up at ONE pantry.

Identification Requirements:

- Michigan driver's license, Michigan State ID or Consular ID Card for all members of the household 18 and over
- Birth certificate or guardianship papers for household members 17 and under
- Copy of current lease or lot rent stating all occupants
- Copy of Utility bill with name and current address
- W2/ pay stubs (3 mos.)
- Copy of ALL forms of income for all members of the household
 - DHS cash assistance
 - Child support
 - Pension
 - SER / Housing assistance

- Bridge card dollar amount
- SS Disability statement if applicable
- Each child living in the household needs a school record with current residence or paperwork verifying that they are homeschooled at that address.
